

## DATA PROTECTION DECLARATION

### 1. Contact for data protection concerns

### 2. General information on data processing

Our processing of personal data is limited to those data which are necessary for the provision of a functioning website as well as our contents and services. We only collect personal data that is actually required for the execution and processing of our tasks and services or that you have voluntarily provided to us. Personal data will only be processed for the purposes agreed with you or if there is any other legal basis.

### 3. Your rights
